This has a nice artsy/noir feel being shot in mono. The location is simple and well lit with the blind shadows on the background wall (although we suspect this was not the same location as the opening still shot). There was some good use of camera angles particularly the over shoulder shots.

The acting was very convincing and the script witty if a little dark at times. This led us to the conclusion that comedic it definitely was but with regards to being light hearted it didn't really hit that brief. The death sequence had some great acting but we felt that the second death would have been even more convincing had it followed immediately after the first death. This is merely a minor tweak in the edit.

That said this was clearly a well-made film with a good black humour script. The acting was good and the technical production was well thought out. The reveal that the cat was strangled received a hearty "arrhhhhh" from us which may be a sad indictment on us that we were quite content with the two actors killing themselves but were devastated that the cat got strangled.
